Minutes of Last Meeting

- 1 Annual General Meeting (AGM):** Proposals for the AGM as discussed by the committee are as follows. Each of these will require a vote from existing teams at the AGM. The AGM is scheduled for 20 July 2026 and as a reminder it is **MANDATORY** for all teams to be represented by their captains or a chose representative or a fine will be incurred. Please add this date to your calendars.
 - Reinstate the draw for league matches. Requested by Cowplain Social Lost Boys: The committee are neutral on this proposal. Basically this would mean all players go into the draw which is completed at before the game starts in full including doubles.
 - If more than 6 players turn up then all of them should be put in the draw. This was submitted by Cowplain Lost Boys. The Committee are neutral on this proposal. The choice of the captain is to decide if players go into the draw or not.
 - In scotch doubles players can talk between shots. This was from The Rainbow. The committee support this proposal. Basically it would mean players can speak every shot but still need to remain within the 1 minute shot clock. In addition if either player touches the table talking needs to stop at that point.
 - Have only 1 Division and play each other home and away. Suggested for discussion by the Committee. Currently we have 2 divisions as decided previously by the committee. 2 divisions means new teams get a good chance to learn the rules and play against similar standards when they enter but conversely it means we do not get to play against all teams. We currently have 11 teams but there is a good chance we could have 13 for the winter league. The committee are neutral on this point.
 - Go back to 2 points for a win and 1 for a draw. Proposed for discussion by the committee who are neutral on this point.
